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Through the beautiful art of henna, our team of young women with their own lived experience as refugees will engage participants with stories of courage and resilience. Following this immersive experience, participants will explore and share their own stories of courage and resilience through artistic endeavours. Participants can anticipate learning how to make henna paste from scratch, design their own henna tattoos, and learn about the history and many uses of henna in diverse cultures across the world.

Language is a powerful tool, shaping how we see and understand the world around us. In this workshop, our facilitators use the beauty of the spoken word to share their stories of arriving in Australia as refugees and the challenges they face as young women of colour. Participants, through interactive group discussions, will unpack these moving stories and the power of language to transform our understanding and our own role in making people feel welcome and creating opportunities for them in our communities.

beyond the face.

An interactive and reflective session using photographic portraits, participants dive into how and why we stereotype people from different backgrounds with a focus on our unconscious and conscious biases. Facilitators will use the art of storytelling to share their experiences as young women from diverse backgrounds and the confronting daily stereotypes and labels. These young women will provide participants with the tools to continue a journey of self reflection and accountability as they interact with an increasingly diverse and interdependent world.

the book of us.

The Book of Us is a creative experience that explores concepts of inclusion and our individual and shared identities. Students will first hear stories from our facilitators of their own journey of courage, resilience and navigating the world as young people from diverse backgrounds. Together we unpack concepts of difference, exclusion and feeling misunderstood as a vehicle to create greater cohesion and connection between students and groups. They will then go on to create their own storybook page that represents their own story and identity, which is then collated into a keepsake book of the group or year level which can be shared with students again in later years as a valuable teaching resource.
