# What is Sexuell Violence



Sexual violence represents various unwanted, non-consenual behaviours and language that makes a person feel uncomfortable, scared or threatended

#### sexual violence

is **NON-CONSENUAL** and **NOT** an act of love or intimacy +



Sexual violence is the responsibility of the perpetrator - NO ONE DESERVES SEXUAL VIOLENCE

## Sexual Violence is NOT

consensual sex sexual intercourse love or intimacy the victims fault lawful In Australia, sexual violence survivors are MOSTLY WOMEN - 5 X MORE FEMALE VICTIMS
OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE were recorded than male in 2019

Almost 2 million adults and 1 IN 6 WOMEN have experienced sexual violence since the age of 15 years.



Almost all perpetrators of sexual violence ARE MALE (97%), with the highest offending rates in males aged 15-19 (2019)

#### MOST SEXUAL VIOLENCE PERPETRATORS ARE KNOWN TO THEIR VICTIMS



#### sexual wiolence

is A CRIME, however, many incidents of sexual violence GO UNREPORTED.

It's estimated ONLY 19% of sexual assaults on females were reported to the police (2005)
